1. Increase Your Sackett-Systems Equipment Expensing in 2008

The 2008 Economic Stimulus Act increases the amount of qualified property that you can expense under Section 179 to \$250,000 for equipment placed in service between December 31, 2007 and January 1, 2009. (Total amount of equipment purchased may not exceed \$800,000.)

Plus Bonus Depreciation in 2008

The law passed in 2008 also creates a bonus depreciation of 50% for qualifying assets. This bonus is in addition to regular first-year 20% depreciation.

You must act soon!

This offer is only good through the end of 2008. Unless Congress extends it, the Tax Code 179 depreciation will go back to \$125,000 with a limit of \$500,000.

Serving the coal industry, we produced Hi Carbo steel chutes and screens. In 1913, our Loading and Screening Outfits were timed to empty, deliver and screen 3 to 5 tons of coal from silos in 1-1/2 to 3 minutes - a record that still stands.

From the coal industry, Sackett branched out to providing the paper mill and concrete distributing industries with material handling equipment.
